Farmers Market Health Department Review

- No Samples
- Farmer will pick products for customers, signs posted
- Limit number of customers at table – have markers to distance
- If used, only cleanable table clothes can be used
- Wipe down credit card machines if used
- Sanitizer wipes or spray available for use
- Handwashing available
- Disposable gloves available
- Do not go to market if sick. If sick, inform the market managers
- Pre-package loose fruits, greens, and vegetables, among other items
- Do not allow customers to handle products they aren't purchasing
- Keep 6 foot distance between you and customers. Place extra table in front to ensure proper distance
- Separate person taking money/handling food
- Food is off ground
- Food protected
- Temperature control adequate for cold items (if applicable)
